Failure to report misconduct may result in penalties up to

termination of employment and revocation of an educator's certificate



All employees and agents of a public school district, charter school or private school have an obligation and a legal responsibility to report misconduct by instructional personnel and school administrators which affects the health, safety or welfare of a student

- **Obscene language**
- **Drug and alcohol use**
- **Disparaging comments**
- **Prejudice or bigotry**
- **Sexual innuendo**
- **Cheating or testing violations**
- **Physical aggression**
- **Accept or offer favors**

If someone tells you about misconduct, be a LEADER:

- Listen
- Evaluate
- Act immediately
- Document
- Encourage
- Report
